DOUG ISENBERG NAMED “GEORGIA SUPER LAWYERS RISING STAR”

ATLANTA, September 28, 2005 – Attorney Doug Isenberg, founder of GigaLaw.com and The GigaLaw Firm, has been named a “Georgia Super Lawyers Rising Star.” The honor is awarded by Law & Politics to attorneys age 40 or younger, or in practice for 10 years or less. Only 2.5 percent of the attorneys in Georgia are selected as Rising Stars.

He has written and spoken extensively on numerous Internet legal issues and is the author of the book *The GigaLaw Guide to Internet Law* (Random House).
