**DOUG ISENBERG CHAIRS “INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW INSTITUTE”
IN SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO**

ATLANTA, November 15, 2005 – Attorney Doug Isenberg, founder of GigaLaw.com and The GigaLaw Firm, co-chaired the Intellectual Property Law Institute in San Juan, Puerto Rico. The annual event is organized in part by the State Bar of Georgia’s Intellectual Property Law Section, for which Isenberg serves as chair for 2005-06.

The IP Institute was held in conjunction with the Southern Regional Entertainment and Sports Law Institute, November 10-14, 2005. The combined continuing legal education event attracted nearly 300 attendees, a record.

This year’s program included speakers from approximately 20 law firms and companies, who addressed timely topics on trademark, copyright and patent law. Highlights included a panel with two federal judges; a discussion of open-source software with in-house counsel from Microsoft and Red Hat; and a roundtable on emerging trends in new media with attorneys from leading law firms and entertainment companies, including the Recording Industry Association of America.

“The IP Institute continues to provide a unique educational and networking opportunity for leading intellectual property attorneys throughout the Southeastern United States and beyond,” Isenberg said.

Isenberg, who has been named a “Georgia Super Lawyers Rising Star,” is a world-renown authority on Internet law and an adjunct professor of computer and cyberspace law at Georgia State University College of Law. He is also a domain name panelist for the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), the largest arbiter of domain name disputes, based in Geneva. He has written and spoken extensively on numerous Internet legal issues and is the author of the book *The GigaLaw Guide to Internet Law* (Random House).
