DOUG ISENBERG TO SPEAK AT “DOMAIN ROUNDTABLE” CONFERENCE

ATLANTA, February 23, 2006 – Attorney Doug Isenberg, founder of GigaLaw.com and The GigaLaw Firm, is scheduled to speak at the Domain Roundtable conference in Seattle, April 19-21, 2006. Isenberg is a world-renown authority on Internet law and a domain name panelist for the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), the largest arbiter of domain name disputes, based in Geneva. Isenberg is also an adjunct professor of computer and cyberspace law at Georgia State University College of Law and has been named a “Georgia Super Lawyers Rising Star.”
