**DOUG ISENBERG TO SPEAK ON “LEGAL AND BUSINESS ISSUES”
AT DOMAIN ROUNDTABLE CONFERENCE**

ATLANTA, May 12, 2005 – Attorney Doug Isenberg, founder of GigaLaw.com and The GigaLaw Firm, will participate in a panel discussion on “Legal and Business Issues” at the first Domain RoundTable Conference in Seattle on May 26, 2005.

Isenberg, a world-renown authority on Internet law and an adjunct professor of computer and cyberspace law, has advised clients on domain name legal issues for nine years. He has successfully represented clients as both complainants and respondents in proceedings under the Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (UDRP) before the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and the National Arbitration Forum. In addition, he was recently appointed as a domain name panelist for WIPO, the largest arbiter of domain name disputes, based in Geneva.

Some of the panelists joining Isenberg for his discussion include Christine Jones, general counsel at The Go Daddy Group, Inc., the world’s largest domain name registrar; Jonathon Nevett, vice president of policy and ethics at Network Solutions, the first registrar of domain names; and Bruce Tonkin, chief technology officer at Melbourne IT, an Australian-based domain name registrar.

The Domain RoundTable Conference, organized by Name Intelligence, Inc., is a three-day event in Seattle that attracts large corporations with trademark and domain name interests, domain name industry insiders, domain name entrepreneurs and others in the general Internet community.
