**DOUG ISENBERG BECOMES CHAIR OF
STATE BAR OF GEORGIA'S INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW SECTION**

ATLANTA, July 1, 2005 – Attorney Doug Isenberg, founder of GigaLaw.com and The GigaLaw Firm, has assumed his responsibilities as chair of the State Bar of Georgia's Intellectual Property Law Section ("IP Section"), a group that serves nearly 1,000 attorneys practicing copyright, trademark and patent law in Georgia. He is an adjunct professor at Georgia State University College of Law, where he serves as a founding member of the Intellectual Property Advisory Board. He is also a world-renown authority on Internet law, the author of The GigaLaw Guide to Internet Law (Random House 2002) and an arbitrator of domain name disputes for the World Intellectual Property Organization ("WIPO"), based in Geneva.
